Ernest (Ernie) James Bradley passed away as the result of a vehicle accident on 18 June 2023, survived by his wife, Erin; his three children James, Jeanette and Shane and their partners; two grandchildren and two great grandchildren.

Ernie was born and brought up in Chermside, Brisbane, and before joining the Regular Army in 1965 was an apprentice wood machinist. A dedicated, reliable and well regarded soldier, he served with 105th Battery on both its tours of Vietnam, in the first tour on

After Vietnam, Ernie stayed on in the Army, serving in Brisbane and Holsworthy before discharging in 1985 in the rank of Staff Sergeant.
