

Paul Stevens, AO

Major General Paul Stevens spent 33 years in the Australian Army. He served in South Vietnam with 105 Field Battery, qualified as an Instructor in Gunnery in the United Kingdom, and was the Battery Commander of 103 Medium Battery. More senior appointments included Commanding Officer of the School of Artillery, Director of Studies at the Australian Command and Staff College, Chief of Staff of Army Training Command, Military Secretary, and Chief of Army Personnel. After his Army career General Stevens became the Services Member of the Repatriation Commission and later the Director of the Office of Australian War Graves.

General Stevens was the Representative Colonel Commandant of the Royal Australian Artillery from 2001 to 2004 and has recently completed a term as a member of the Australian War Memorial Council. He has a personal interest in history and has published articles on the artillery at Fromelles.
