Australia's Memorial Walk Guide





Harbour Trust Australia's Memorial Walk was initiated in 2002 to honour those who served and supported the defence of Australia in peace or in war.

Located within the Harbour Trust's North Head Sanctuary in a bushland setting, the Walk is 250 metres and includes five major monuments and a Lone Pine memorial sited either side of the central path of pavers. It sits adjacent to a WWII coast defence artillery battery site which you can visit after the Walk.


